NOTICE OF PROPOSED RATE CHANGES FOR ¾" METERED CUSTOMERS

LakeLand Village Water Company has asked the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission for permission to increase the water rates we charge all our customers. The proposed rates will increase annual revenues to the company by approximately \$82,743 (30.8%) per year to cover increased operating expenses of labor, insurance, fuel, electricity, etc. If approved, the new rates will be effective on November 1, 2021. The rate increase will be based on water used after November 1, and reflected on your January 2022 billing.

Below is a table showing the current and proposed water rates for ¾" meters (cu ft = cubic feet):

Monthly Rates	Current Rate
Base Rate	\$11.00
0-500 cu ft per 100 cu ft	\$1.60
501-1,000 cu ft per 100 cu ft	\$1.70
Over 1,000 cu ft per 100 cu ft	\$2.00

Monthly Rates	Proposed Rate
Base Rate (zero cubic feet of usage)	\$15.00
0-500 cu ft per 100 cu ft	\$1.80
501-1,000 cu ft per 100 cu ft	\$2.15
Over 1,000 cu ft per 100 cu ft	\$3.00

One cu ft = approx. 7.48 gallons of water

Below is a list of changes to other fee charges that may affect you:

Disconnection Visit Charge	n/a	\$50.00
Reconnection Visit Charge	\$25.00	\$50.00
Service Visit Charge	n/a	\$50.00
Late Payment Charge *	n/a	\$2.50
Account Setup	n/a	\$50.00
NSF Check Charge	n/a	\$12.00
Service Connection Charge	\$200.00	\$500.00
Water Availability Letter	n/a	\$25.00

*The late payment charge is a minimum of \$2.50 or 2% of the delinquent balance, whichever is greater. Payment is considered late 15 days after the water bills are mailed to you.

If you have any questions about the proposed filing and how it will affect you, please call LakeLand Village Water Company at 360.275.2474. The commission has the authority to set final rates that may be either lower or higher than the company's request, depending on the results of the investigation.
