Dear Ms. Maxwell:

Our company has been notified that the tipping fee in Clark County will increase from \$97.39 to \$99.88 per non-drop box ton, a 2.56% increase, and from \$86.50 to \$88.72 per drop box ton, a 2.57% increase, effective January 1, 2022. We project this will increase revenue for residential service by \$121,500 (1.11%); for commercial service by \$60,000 (1.18%); and drop box service by \$68,000 (2.57%) for a 12-month period. There are approximately 71,800 residential, 4,300 commercial and 400 drop box customers affected by this change.

The last general rate increase approved by the Commission was effective January 1, 2018.

Attached are revised tariff pages and supporting documentation containing the revised rates. If these rates are approved by the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission they will become effective January 1, 2022.

Pursuant to WAC 480-70-271(2)(a)(iii), affected customers will receive notification of the change on the first billing reflecting the revision to rates.
