Re: Review Committee Decision – Case 21-051 City of Longview vs. Allied Resources Group

Dear Amanda Maxwell:

The Washington State Dig Law Safety Committee received a complaint regarding a potential violation of Washington State Dig Law RCW 19.122.030 for work performed on November 10, 2021.

On April 27, 2022, the committee formed a review board and heard Case 21-051 filed by the City of Longview against Allied Resources Group.

The review panel determined that the respondent, Allied Resources Group, violated RCW 19.122.030(1) & (2) by failing to white line excavation site and call for locates before jobsite work.

Therefore, the committee recommends a total penalty of \$1000 being assessed to the respondent as follows:

- \$1000 for one violation of RCW 19.122.030(1) & (2)

The recommended penalty is \$1000.00
