TATOOSH WATER COMPANY RATE ADJUSTMENT

Tatoosh Water Company has asked the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission to approve an application to increase rates. If approved, the new rates will become effective November 1, 2023. If approved, this increase would generate approximately 36% more in monthly revenue to cover expenses.

REASON FOR INCREASE

The water rate increase will help cover increased expenses such as contract operations, repairs, maintenance, and insurance. The current rates were set in 2021 and do not cover current expenses.

THE NEW RATES:

Meters are read and bills produced monthly. The following table is a monthly comparison of the current and proposed rates per cubit foot (cu.ft.) of water.

Base Rate (zero allowance)	\$40.00
0-600 (cf)	\$1.20
601-1,200 (cf)	\$2.50
Over 1,201 (cf)	\$3.25

Proposed Monthly Rates	Proposed Rate
Base Rate (zero allowance)	\$45.00
0-600 (cf)	\$1.50
601-1,200 (cf)	\$2.50
Over 1,201 (cf)	\$3.50

Usage rates are per 100 cf. One cubic foot=approx.7.48 gallons.
