Re: TV-230822 - Rescinding Cancellation of Permit

Dear SWAGG LLC:

On October 9, 2023, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) cancelled SWAGG LLC, d/b/a Shields Transition Services,'s Household Goods Carriers permit THG070142, for failure to file proof of liability and property damage insurance covering equipment.

It has come to our attention that insurance covering Household Goods Carriers permit THG070142 was filed with the Commission. The Commission records now reflect that proof of liability and property damage insurance covering [permit or certificate] THG070142 is properly filed.

The Commission, therefore, rescinds the cancellation and reissues permit THG070142 in the name of SWAGG LLC. The permit is enclosed, and the company may again operate on a permanent basis.

SWAGG LLC must continue to comply with state laws and Commission rules. Failure to do so will result in Commission enforcement action, up to and including revocation of the company's permit.
