**NOTICE WITHDRAWING  
NOTICE OF INTENT TO CANCEL CERTIFICATION AS A SOLID WASTE  
COMPANY AND OPPORTUNITY TO REQUEST A HEARING**

RE: *Vanderveen Family Transport, Inc.*,  
Docket TG-230835

TO ALL PARTIES:

On November 30, 2023, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) issued a Notice of Intent to Cancel Certification as a Solid Waste Company and Opportunity to Request a Hearing (Notice) after it determined that Vanderveen Family Transport, Inc. (Vanderveen) failed to comply with regulatory reporting requirements and/or failed to pay the required regulatory fees.

Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 480-70-071(1) and WAC 480-70-076 provide that every solid waste company is required to file an annual report<sup>1</sup> and must pay regulatory fees by May 1 of every year.<sup>2</sup> WAC 480-70-071(1)(d) authorizes the Commission to cancel an entity's solid waste company certificate if the entity fails to file its annual report or pay the annual vehicle fees.<sup>3</sup>

Vanderveen was provided with 30 days starting from the service date to respond to the Notice by either complying with the WAC 480-31-080 regulatory requirements or by requesting a hearing.

On February 21, 2024, Commission staff (Staff) informed the Director of the Administrative law Division that Vanderveen came into compliance and that Staff no longer supported cancellation of Vanderveen.

**THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE that it withdraws the earlier Notice of Intent to Cancel Certification as a Solid Waste Company and Opportunity to Request a Hearing issued against Vanderveen Family Transport, Inc. in this docket.**
