On September 5, 2025, Harris, Thomas Earl, d/b/a Earl's Affordable Moving, filed an application with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) to reinstate the company's permit to provide residential household goods transportation services in the state of Washington.

The Commission grants Harris, Thomas Earl's request to reinstate permit HG065027 for permanent household goods carrier authority and approves the application in full. Permit HG065027 issued in the name of Harris, Thomas Earl is enclosed, and the company may operate on a permanent basis.
