NOTICE OF TECHNICAL WORKSHOP (Set for 1 p.m. on Thursday, October 15, 2020)

RE: Investigation of Puget Sound Energy's Compliance with RCW 80.28 and WAC 480-100, Docket U-190748

On September 6, 2019, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) initiated an investigation in Docket U-190748 to determine whether Puget Sound Energy (PSE) complied with the Revised Code of Washington (RCW) 80.28 and Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 480-110, regarding the public utility tax exemption to Lummi Nation tribal members (Tribe) living on tribal lands.

On September 23, 2020, Commission staff (Staff) filed its final investigative report which recommended, among other things, that PSE participate in a workgroup with Staff, the Department of Revenue, the Tribe and other interested stakeholders to establish a process for certifying tax exempt status for PSE customers.¹
