Dear Mr. Killip:

Enclosed, please find revised pages, 2 and 33 to the above-referenced tariff. These proposed revised tariff pages contain rate changes that impact industrial customers with CDL, industrial processing waste, and foundry slag casing going to Graham Road Landfill. The rate for CDL is increasing to \$50.10/ton from \$46.40/ton and the rate for industrial processing waste is increasing from \$35.50/ton to \$38.34/ton. The rate for foundry slag casing is increasing from \$25.25/ton to \$27.27/ton. The annual revenue increase from this adjustment is expected to be \$200. We are requesting this filing be approved April 1, 2024.

I have included notification from the disposal facility on the increase.
