Re: TV-240304 - Rescinding Cancellation of Permit

Dear Ballard Preferred Moving, Inc.:

On May 2, 2024, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) cancelled Ballard Preferred Moving, Inc.'s Household Goods Carriers permit HG058059, for failure to file proof of cargo insurance.

It has come to our attention that insurance covering Household Goods Carriers permit HG058059 has now been filed with the Commission. The Commission records now reflect that proof of liability and property damage insurance covering [permit or certificate] HG058059 is properly filed.

The Commission, therefore, rescinds the cancellation and reissues permit HG058059 in the name of Ballard Preferred Moving, Inc.. The permit is enclosed, and the company may again operate on a permanent basis.

Ballard Preferred Moving, Inc. must continue to comply with state laws and Commission rules. Failure to do so will result in Commission enforcement action, up to and including revocation of the company's permit.
