ICNU is an incorporated, non-profit association of large industrial electric customers in the Pacific Northwest. Many members of ICNU purchase power and power delivery services from Puget Sound Energy ("PSE"), as indicated on Attachment A. ICNU has been a party to many proceedings before the Commission involving PSE, including PSE's most recent general rate case (UE-111048/UG-111049).

ICNU's member companies have a substantial interest in PSE's revisions to its Electric Schedule 95A. The Commission's decision whether or not to pass through to customers interest credit on the unamortized balance of U.S. Treasury Department grants required by the amended Section 1603 of the 2009 American Recovery and Reinvestment Tax Act would substantially and directly affect those of ICNU's members who purchase power services from PSE. ICNU requests leave to intervene in this proceeding to represent its members who are affected by the outcome.

ICNU has extensive experience in proceedings involving PSE. ICNU has already filed a response brief in this proceeding and believes that its continued participation will assist the Commission. Furthermore, ICNU's intervention in this proceeding will not unreasonably broaden the issues, burden the record, or delay this proceeding.
