In accordance with the Interpretive and Policy Statement issued on June 28, 1996 in Docket No. UT-960269, please find enclosed an original and two (2) copies of the Amendment for: CLEC-to-CLEC Cross-Connections to the Interconnection Agreement between XO Washington, Inc., formerly known as NEXTLINK Washington, Inc. and Qwest Corporation for the State of Washington.

The enclosed Amendment does not discriminate against non-party carriers. It is consistent with the public interest, convenience, and necessity. It is also consistent with applicable state law requirements, including Commission orders regarding interconnection issues.
