**FRONT AND CENTERED AND NW ENERGY COALITION DATA REQUEST NO. 225:**

**Topic:** Phillips Testimony (Vulnerable Population Analysis)

Witness Phillips testifies that “[s]ince submitting the CEIP, PSE has already constructed multiple internal dashboards and performed analyses on programs related to equity. These analyses show how vulnerability intersects with factors such as program participation in energy efficiency, voluntary renewables programs, and energy assistance.” AJP-1T at 25:6–25:9.

- a. Please provide these internal analyses and all supporting documents.
- b. Does PSE plan to make these internal dashboards and other analyses publicly available? If so, when and how?
- c. Will any publicly available dashboards or other analyses track CBIs and metrics, including baseline data and progress over time?

**Response:**

- a. The internal analysis referenced in Front and Centered and NW Energy Coalition Data Request No. 225(a) involves multiple internal dashboards and, therefore, cannot be provided in document form. The dashboards are connected to live, internal data within Puget Sound Energy’s (“PSE”) SAP and SAP HANA Customer Information System.
- b. PSE has not determined if or how to display these internal dashboards. However, PSE intends to report customer benefit indicator (“CBI”) metrics at the cadence prescribed by (Clean Energy Transformation Act (CETA)/Clean Energy Implementation Plan (“CEIP”) rules, which summarize the results of program performance at the correct intervals.
- c. In the 2023 biennial CEIP update, PSE intends to report on CBIs and metrics, including baseline data and progress over time.
