Total MASTER Lifetime Earnings Theoretical (Earnings for ages 40-90): \$9 million



Total PSP PILOT Lifetime Earnings Theoretical (Earnings for ages 40-90): \$15.7 million



Assumptions:

Company X salary at 90+% of \$200,000 per year. Retirement is 1.5% per year of service credited for total years at highest pay level. PSP DNI at \$400,000 per year. Exam at 40 years old. One-year waiting period post exam. Two-year training period. Six Year Buy-in Period. Six Year Buy-Out Period. Retirement is 1.5% per year of service credited for total years at highest DNI level. Retirement at 70 years old. Mortality at 90 years old.

No changes in compensation levels, no accounting for benefits aside from retirement, no present value calculation, no inflation.
