### NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY TO FILE WRITTEN RESPONSES (Due by August 27, 2021)

RE: Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission v. Cascade Natural Gas Corporation, Docket UG-152286

#### TO ALL PARTIES:

On December 1, 2015, Cascade Natural Gas Corporation (Cascade or Company) filed a general rate case with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission). On July 7, 2016, the Commission entered Order 04, Final Order Approving Settlement Agreement (Order 04), which authorized Cascade's decoupling mechanism, among other things.<sup>1</sup>

On July 9, 2021, Cascade filed a Petition to Amend Order 04 (Petition), requesting that the Commission authorize Cascade to "extend its decoupling mechanism until its next full general rate case expected to be filed in late-2022 or early-2023, thus allowing the matter to be fully adjudicated on whether the mechanism should be sustained or abolished."<sup>2</sup>

Pursuant to WAC 480-07-875, the Commission provides all parties to Docket UG-152286 the opportunity to file written responses to Cascade's Petition.
