NOTICE GRANTING REQUEST FOR CONTINUANCE

TO ALL PARTIES:

On June 15, 2010, the Commission entered Order 03 setting a prehearing conference in this matter for July 20, 2010.

On July 15, 2010, Commission Staff filed with the Commission a letter requesting a continuance of the conference to August 27, 2010. The reason for the continuance is that Staff is still engaged in its review of the work papers provided by the companies in mid-June. Further discovery of the companies' operations by Staff is also pending. The continuance will allow Staff to determine the extent of any controversy raised by the tariff filings, which, in turn, will allow the parties a better opportunity for full or partial settlement before the remainder of the cases is settled.
