TO ALL PARTIES:

On March 24, 2016, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered Order 01 Granting Amended Accounting Petition (Order 01) in dockets UE-160203 and UG-160204. Order 01, among other things, required Puget Sound Energy (PSE or Company) to file updates every three months related to the Fee-Free Credit and Debit Card Payment Program's progress.

PSE filed an update and report on May 28, 2018.

On May 30, 2018, Commission staff (Staff) filed a letter informing the Commission that Staff had reviewed the update and determined that the updates complied with the requirements of Order 01.

The Commission accepts the update filed on May 28, 2018, as in compliance with Order 01.
