Dear Sir or Madam:

As you are aware, on December 1, 2017, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission issued a Penalty Assessment against Lifestyle Shuttles & Tours in the amount of \$1,300 for violations of WAC 480-30-221 Vehicle and Driver Safety Requirements. On January 29, 2018, the Commission granted the company's request for mitigation, and reduced the penalty to \$600. The Commission sent you a Final Notice dated July 18, 2018, indicating that the balance of \$375 was due. A payment in the amount of \$100 was made on September 26, 2018, leaving a balance of \$175.

The Commission has not received the remaining \$175 payment due and owing.

This is to notify you that the Commission intends to forward your outstanding debt to a collection agency for collection. You likely will incur additional expenses and fees, including costs of collection, attorney's fees, and interest. These expenses and fees will be added to your outstanding \$175 balance.
