- A. My name is Cara G. Peterman, and my business address is P.O. Box 97034, Bellevue, Washington 98009-9734.
- Q. By whom are you employed and in what capacity?
- I am employed by Puget Sound Energy ("PSE") as Director, Chief Risk Officer, A. and Corporate Treasurer.
- Q. What are your duties as Corporate Treasurer for PSE?
- As Director, Chief Risk Officer and Corporate Treasurer for PSE, I have the A. responsibility for managing PSE's Enterprise Risk Management Program and Treasury functions. In Treasury, I have oversight of the administering PSE's short-term debt program, administering PSE's long-term debt portfolio, and dayto-day management of PSE's cash position. I am also responsible for interfacing with credit rating agencies as well as with commercial and investment banks and debt investors. I am a member of the Qualified Plan's Committee, which oversees PSE's retirement, 401(k) and health and welfare plans. Finally, I am a board member and the Treasurer of the Puget Sound Energy Foundation.

A. I earned a Bachelor of Arts degree in Economics from the University of Puget

I joined PSE in 2004 and have had held a variety of positions in energy supply, resource acquisition, finance, office of the CEO, compliance, and enterprise risk management.

In 2011, I was promoted to management overseeing the Financial Planning & Analysis team and led the development of the annual five-year business plan and production of the monthly corporate outlook of current-year performance and forecast results.

In 2014, I transitioned to work with the office of the CEO on special projects and board communications. Later that year, I was promoted to Director, Enterprise Risk Management ("ERM"), and charged with developing a corporate ERM framework whereby management systematically identifies, evaluates, and manages risk facing the company.
