DENYING REQUEST FOR REVIEW

BACKGROUND

- 1 On March 21, 2024, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) issued Order 02 Canceling Payment Arrangement (Order 02) in the Matter of the Investigation of PNW Moving and Delivery, LLC (PNW Moving or Company), for compliance with Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 480-15.
- On April 8, 2024, PNW Moving filed a letter to the docket requesting that the 2 Commission continue its payment plan, which the Commission construes as a request for review of Order 02 (Request for Review). PNW Moving indicated that it would have difficult paying the \$9,800 outstanding penalty balance, which was made immediately due and payable by Order 02.

DISCUSSION AND DECISION

Order 02 explains: 3

> This is an order delegated to the Executive Secretary for decision. As authorized in WAC 480-07-904(3), you must file any request for Commission review of this Order no later than 14 days after the date the decision is posted on the Commission's website.

Any request for review of Order 02 was therefore due by April 4, 2024, 14 days after it was entered. PNW Moving filed its Request for Review four days later on April 8, 2024. The Company does not provide any explanation for why it was unable to comply with the deadline or otherwise establish good cause for its late filing. Pro se litigants are bound by the same rules of procedure and substantive law as other parties. The Request for Review is therefore denied as untimely, and without good cause for the delay in filing.

ORDER

THE COMMISSION ORDERS That PNW Moving and Delivery, LLC's Request for Review is DENIED.
