Dear Mr. Danner:

In August actual net power costs under the ERM were lower than authorized costs by \$2,041,334. The year-to-date difference is \$1,805,070 in the surcharge direction, which is within the \$4 M deadband. No deferral entry is made when the difference is within the \$4 M deadband.

In August Lancaster related costs amounted to \$683,823 in the surcharge direction, with year-to-date costs totaling \$8,229,560 in the surcharge direction. No deferral entry was made for accounting purposes. If the Settlement Stipulation entered into in Docket Nos. UE-100467 and UG-100468 is approved by the WUTC, the total deferral for Lancaster for 2010 would be limited to \$6.8 million. The Company will not record additional deferrals for the ERM, or Lancaster pending the WUTC's decision on the Settlement Stipulation.
