MEMORANDUM

- *I* On September 29, 2000, the Commission entered its Third Supplemental Order ("Third Order") in this matter. In it, the Commission rejected in their entirety the tariff revisions then suspended, and ordered Avista Corporation ("Avista" or "the Company") to file tariffs consistent with the Third Order.
- 2 On October 23, 2000, Avista Corporation (Avista or Company) filed a petition for reconsideration and Staff filed a petition for clarification. On November 8, 2000, the Commission issued a notice that the compliance filing would not be required to go into effect until such time as the Commission entered an order on reconsideration in these matters.
- 3 On November 9, 2000, the Commission entered its Fourth Supplemental Order ("Fourth Order") in this proceeding fully resolving all issues in this matter. The Commission ordered Avista to refile tariffs consistent with the Fourth Order.
- 4 On November 15, 2000, Avista filed tariff revisions to comply with the Third and Fourth Orders. On November 17, 2000, the Company submitted substitute tariff sheet 146.
- 5 On November 21, 2000, the Commission Staff informed the Commission that Staff reviewed the compliance tariffs, including substitute tariff sheet 146, and concluded that they appear to comply in all respects with the Third and Fourth Orders. No other parties commented on the compliance tariffs.
- 6 The Commission finds that the tariff revisions filed by the Company on November 15, 2000, and the substitute tariff sheet 146 filed on November 17, 2000, are consistent with the Commission's Third and Fourth Orders and concludes therefore that the tariff revisions should be approved as filed.

ORDER

7 The tariff revisions filed by Avista Corporation on November 15, 2000, in accordance with the Third and Fourth Supplemental Orders in the proceeding, shall become effective as filed. The rates, charges, and conditions set forth in the tariff revisions are specified as the rates, charges, and conditions to be applicable to service on and after December 1, 2000.
