The Commission entered its Fourth Supplemental Order in these dockets on March 4, 2002. The Order, among other things, rejected a tariff proposal by Avista Corporation, d/b/a Avista Utilities (Avista), but authorized and required the Company to file tariff sheets consistent with terms of the Order. The Order also authorized the Commission's Executive Secretary to approve the authorized filing by letter if it complied with the terms of the Order.
