Footnote 42 identifies the three petitions for declaratory ruling that were consolidated into this Docket. Those petitions were filed by SBC and BellSouth in May 2004. All three petitions are attached hereto for the Commission's information. The SBC petition (provided as Attachment B) addresses action taken by the state of Michigan in connection with the Sage Telecom agreement. BellSouth filed a petition for forbearance (provided as Attachment C), as well as a petition for an emergency declaratory ruling (provided as Attachment D). Those petitions were prompted by the SBC petition, as well as by an inquiry from the Florida Public Service Commission to BellSouth as to whether BellSouth intended to file certain commercial agreements.
