- 2) WRRA is a trade association representing the vast majority of regulated solid waste collection companies in Washington state. Matters involving regulation of the solid waste industry are of interest to the members of WRRA, who would not be parties in this action. WRRA was granted intervention in the related Application Dockets filed by DTG in TG-240583 & TG-240584. This docket shares many factual and legal issues with the application proceedings.
