Avista Corporation, dba Avista Utilities (Avista or the Company), submits the following comments in accordance with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission's (Commission) Notice of Opportunity to File Written Comments (Notice) issued in Docket UE-210553 on September 13, 2021 relating to the Commission's Request for Proposals (RFP) to solicit a qualified consultant to support the Commission's examination of energy decarbonization impacts and pathways for electric and gas utilities to meet state emissions targets as described in RCW 70A.45.020.

The Company has reviewed the draft RFP and does not have any comments to offer on the RFP itself. Selecting a qualified consultant is important as it will hopefully provide support and expertise to the Commission's examination. We would ask that the Commission entertain public participation element to the selection of the consultant.
