COMPLAINANTS' MOTION TO AMEND SCHEDULING ORDER

v.

AT&T COMMUNICATIONS OF THE PACIFIC NORTHWEST, INC.; and T-NETIX, INC.,

- 1. The Commission recently issued Order 15, which amended the scheduling order and revised the procedural schedule. Under the Order, T-Netix's responses to AT&T's and Complainants' data requests were due by February 13, 2009. The Order also provided that "[i]f Complainants or AT&T do not receive responses to their data requests from T-Netix by the deadline set forth in this order, either Complainants or AT&T may notify the Commission at that time." *See* Order 15, p. 2, n. 3.
- 2. T-Netix served supplemental responses to AT&T's and Complainants' Data Requests on February 13, 2009. On the same day, T-Netix sent a DVD containing electronic documents, which was received by Counsel for Complainants late in the afternoon on February 17, 2009. Counsel for T-Netix has indicated that it is continuing to review emails for relevance and privilege and expects to send another DVD by FedEx overnight on Thursday, February 20, 2009.
- 3. Mr. Youtz, lead counsel for the Complainants, was set to review the documents that were due on February 13 on February 14, 15 and 16 in order to determine what depositions were necessary and discuss the discovery with

Complainants' expert. This is because Mr. Youtz was leaving for a long-standing trip

out of the country between February 19 and March 3 and needed to review the

discovery prior to his departure. As recognized in Order 15, data requests should be

fully responded to prior to noting and taking depositions. See Order 15, ¶¶7-10. Under

the existing schedule, all depositions must be completed by March 13.

4. The delay in the production of documents by T-Netix justifies a modest

extension to the schedule. The Complainants request that the current deadlines for

depositions and responsive briefing set forth in Appendix A to Order 15 be extended by

two weeks. Under this proposal, depositions must be completed by March 27, and

responsive briefing would be due on April 10. Complainants' counsel has discussed

this request with counsel for AT&T and T-Netix and they are in agreement with this

extension request.

5. Accordingly, Complainants request that their motion adjusting the current

case schedule be granted.
