Dear Amanda Maxwell:

On October 21, 2021, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered Order 05, Final Order Approving and Adopting Settlement Agreement.

On October 14, 2022, in compliance with Order 05, Northwest Natural Gas Company (NW Natural) filed revised tariff sheets. The revisions to Tariff WN U-6 reflect the authorized \$3 million increase for year 2. Staff has verified that the tariff rates for year 2 properly reflect the revenue requirement approved by the Commission in Order 05, with those rates subject to refund through the review and reconciliation process approved by the Commission in Order 05 if they do not properly reflect plant placed in service during the year.

Commission Staff reviewed the compliance filing provided by NW Natural dated October 14, 2022, and finds that it complies with the Commission's Order 05, entered October 21, 2021.
