RE: Notice of Intent to Send to Collections, Penalty Assessment No. TV-051608

Dear Mr. Thompson:

As you are aware, on October 31, 2005, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission ("commission") issued a Penalty Assessment against Advance Relocation Experts, in the amount of \$2,100 for several violations of commission rules. On April 6, 2006, you entered into a Payment Plan Agreement in which you agreed to pay the commission \$1900 over a period of 18 months, with the first 17 installments totaling \$105.56 each. The final installment is in the amount of \$105.48. Although you made a number of the required installment payments, your last payment of \$200 on August 1, 2007, leaves an outstanding balance of \$385.

This is to notify you that the commission intends to forward your outstanding debt to a collection agency for collection. You likely will incur additional expenses and fees, including costs of collection, attorney's fees, and interest. These expenses and fees will be added to your outstanding \$385 balance.
