TO ALL PARTIES:

On June 1, 2017, Avista Corporation (Avista or Company) filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) its annual Energy and Emissions Intensity (EEI) report for 2016 in accordance with Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 480-109-300.

On June 26, 2018, Commission staff (Staff) filed a letter stating that it had reviewed the EEI report. In its letter, Staff provided feedback regarding areas of potential improvement in future reports while acknowledging that Avista has already incorporated some of that feedback into its 2017 EEI report filed on May 31, 2018, in docket UE-180480.

The Commission has reviewed the Company's EEI report, and acknowledges that the report complies with the requirements of WAC 480-109-300. The Commission encourages Avista and Staff to continue working together to incrementally improve the uniformity and consistency of reporting with each reporting cycle.
