NOTICE CANCELLING BRIEF ADJUDICATIVE PROCEEDING

RE: In the Matter of the Investigation of 3Z Movers, LLC for Compliance with WAC 480-15-560 and WAC 480-15-570

TO ALL PARTIES:

In November 2018, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission's (Commission) staff (Staff) inspected the operations of 3Z Movers, LLC (3Z Movers or Company) and documented 24 violations of Washington Administrative Code 480-15. Based on these violations, Staff proposed a "conditional" safety rating for 3Z Movers and notified the Company of the proposed rating on January 10, 2019.

On January 15, 2019, the Commission issued a notice informing 3Z Movers that the Commission would cancel the Company's household goods carrier certificate as of March 12, 2019, unless the Company obtained Commission approval of a safety management plan prior to that date. In the notice, the Commission scheduled a brief adjudicative proceeding for February 26, 2019, to allow parties an opportunity to make oral statements.

On February 21, 2019, Staff filed a letter stating that the Company had submitted to Staff a safety plan, which staff had evaluated and believes is acceptable.

Staff explained that it spoke with the Company and was told that the Company accepts the conditions outlined in Staff's safety management plan evaluation and waives its right to a hearing. Taking into consideration the Company's request to cancel the hearing, as well as Staff's acceptance of the Company's safety management plan, the Commission finds good cause to cancel the brief adjudicative proceeding set for February 26, 2019, and will enter an order in this proceeding based on a paper record.
