I am writing in full support of PSE's revised tariff filing of January 18, 2024. Their request to extend Schedule 150 will provide critical certainty for consumers while a value of solar study is conducted. The value of solar study is a necessary step to determine the appropriate tariff for customer generated solar in the future. The requested extension of Schedule 150 provides consumer certainty and industry stability while that work is completed. It's important to note that the 4% threshold set out in 80.60 is a minimum capacity threshold, not a maximum.

I respectfully ask that you please grant PSE's request for approval to continue the existing net metering compensation rate until at least December 31, 2025.
