TO ALL PARTIES:

The Commission entered its Order No. 06 Approving and Adopting Settlement Agreement Subject to Conditions; Rejecting Tariff Sheets; Authorizing and Requiring Compliance Filing in this docket on October 27, 2004. The Commission entered its Order No. 07 Granting Clarification, Denying Motion For Stay, and Denying Petitions For Reconsideration on November 10, 2004. These orders, among other things, rejected a tariff proposal by PacifiCorp, but authorized and required the Company to file tariff sheets consistent with terms of the orders. The orders also authorized the Commission's Executive Secretary to approve the authorized filing by letter if it complied with the terms of the orders.

On November 12, 2004, PacifiCorp filed tariff sheets as specified in the orders. A list of the tariff sheets is attached to this letter. The Commission has examined the filing and it appears to comply with the terms of the orders.

Therefore, pursuant to terms of the Commission's prior orders in this proceeding, the tariff sheets indicated on the attachment to this letter will become effective as filed with an effective date of November 16, 2004.
