Dear Mr. Gellatly:

I have received your e-mail dated June 13, 2009, indicating that you would file an amended application in Docket TG-081576 requesting the same authority as previously held by Points Recycling and Refuse, LLC (Points Recycling) as well as an application for temporary authority on Monday, June 15, 2009. However, since your e-mail, the Commission has not received an amended application or an application for temporary authority on behalf of Freedom 2000, LLC.

As you are aware, Freedom 2000's original application only sought authority to operate as a curbside recycling hauler within the Point Roberts service area. In order to request authority similar to what Points Recycling previously held, Freedom 2000 could either file an amended application adding the curbside garbage pickup to its original request, or it could withdraw its original application and refile a new application containing the entire authority Freedom 2000 is seeking. Either option will require a new 30 day notice for protests.

With regard to an application for temporary authority, that application would not be processed through this docket. Instead, it would be addressed entirely by the Commission's regulatory staff.

As a result of the uncertainty of solid waste collection in the Point Roberts service area and the various options still available to Freedom, I am inclined to move forward with the status conference scheduled for July 6, 2009, so that the Commission can receive an update from Freedom 2000 as to the company's intentions.
