ORDER GRANTING APPLICATION
AND
AMENDING PRESENT CERTIFICATE

The Eastern Washington Natural Gas Company, Inc., a Washington corporation, on January 7, 1958, filed with the Commission an application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to Operate a Gas Plant for Hire in Endicott, Washington, and vicinity. The company at present operates a gas plant for hire in Ritzville, Washington, and was issued Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to Operate a Gas Plant for Hire No. 10, in Cause No. U-8891 for that area.

Eastern Washington's present application encompasses the Town of Endicott and immediate vicinity plus a narrow strip of land extending some 1,800 feet north of the town to the Pacific Northwest Pipeline Corporation's Lewiston lateral. Endicott, with a population of approximately 450, is located about 30 miles southeast of Ritzville in a prosperous agricultural area.

Eastern Washington Natural Gas Company, Inc., is the only company which has requested a certificate to supply gas service to the Endicott area. The company has secured a franchise from the Town of Endicott to operate a gas plant for hire.

The feasibility study supporting the company's application is based on supplying gas primarily to residences with very few commercial or industrial customers. The study indicates that the area offers little possibility for significant future growth. Therefore, the success of any company supplying gas service will depend largely upon its ability to sign up a major portion of existing residential customers. The Commission feels that the company's experience in supplying gas service to Ritzville, which, while larger, has basically the same economic stability as Endicott, and should have provided dependable information for the company's feasibility report.

Because of the geographical proximity of Endicott to Ritzville it would appear that a gas operation in Endicott would also lead to a more efficient use of company personnel in both towns.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Eastern Washington Natural Gas Company, Inc., a Washington corporation, operates a gas plant for hire in this state and is subject to the jurisdiction of this Commission.
- 2. Eastern Washington Natural Gas Company, Inc. has heretofore been issued in Cause No. U-8891, Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 10, to operate a gas plant for hire in Ritzville, Washington, and vicinity. The present certificated area is fully delineated in the Order in Cause No. U-8891, Appendix A-1.
- 3. Eastern Washington Natural Gas Company, Inc. requests a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to Operate a Gas Plant for Hire in Endicott and vicinity in Whitman County, Washington.
- 4. At present there is no gas company operating a gas plant for hire in the area in question.
- 5. The Commission has no other application requesting certification for the area sought by Eastern Washington Natural Gas Company, Inc.
- 6. Eastern Washington Natural Gas Company's plans for supplying gas service in the area encompassed in its application appear to be economically feasible.
- 7. The operation of a gas plant for hire by the Eastern Washington Natural Gas Company, Inc. in the Endicott area is or will be required by the public convenience and necessity.
- 8. The Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity presently held by Eastern Washington Natural Gas Company, Inc. should be amended to include Endicott and vicinity as requested.

ORDER

- 1. IT IS HEREBY ORDERED That the application of Eastern Washington Natural Gas Company, Inc. for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to Operate a Gas Plant for Hire in Endicott and vicinity in Whitman County, Washington, is approved and the company's present Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to Operate a Gas Plant for Hire be amended to encompass the additional area as follows:
- a. All of the incorporated area comprising the Town of Endicott and additional portion of Whitman County, Washington, adjacent thereto lying within the area described as follows:

Beginning at the northeast corner of Sec. 31, T 17 N, R 41 E, W.M., in the County of Whitman, State of Washington, running thence east on the north line of Sec. 32, T 17 N, R 41 E, W.M. a distance of 700 feet; thence south on a line parallel with the west line of said Sec. 32 a distance of 3,000 feet; thence west on a line parallel with the north line of said Sec. 31 a distance of 3,200 feet; thence north on a line parallel with the east line of said Sec. 31 a distance of 4,000 feet; thence east on a line parallel with the south line of Sec. 30, T 17 N, R 41 E, W.M. a distance of 1,425 feet; thence northeasterly to the right-of-way of the Pacific Northwest Pipeline Corporation's Lewiston lateral, such point is 825 feet west of the east line of Sec. 30, T 17 N, R 41 E, W.M.; thence east on a line parallel with the south line of said Sec. 30 a distance of 300 feet; thence southwesterly to a point 1,475 feet west of the east line and 1,000 feet north of the south line of said Sec. 30; thence east on a line parallel with the south line of said Sec. 30 to a point of intersection with the east line of Sec. 30; thence south on the east line of said Sec. 30 to point of beginning.

As further shown on Appendix A-2 attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

- 2. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED That the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity issued pursuant to Order paragraph No. 1 above, supersedes and cancels Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 10, issued to Eastern Washington Natural Gas Company, Inc., on April 3, 1957, in Cause No. U-8891. Said Certificate of April 3, 1957, should be forthwith returned to this Commission.
- 3. IT IS FURTHER/ORDERED That jurisdiction over this cause is retained to effectuate the provisions of this order.


