## Puget Sound Energy Energy Independence Act Final Renewable Compliance Report – 2022 Docket UE-220405

Under RCW.19.285.040(2)(a)(ii) and WAC 480-109-200(1)(b), the 2022 renewable energy target for Puget Sound Energy (PSE or the Company), is 3,084,363 megawatt-hours. Under RCW 19.285.040(2)(a), each qualifying utility shall use eligible renewable resources or acquire equivalent renewable energy credits (RECs), or a combination of both, to meet annual renewable targets. Please see Attachment 1 for the renewable generation acquired and/or the RECs (including associated Extra Apprenticeship Credits and Distributed Generation two times multipliers when applicable) retired for PSE's 2022 compliance year summarized by vintage year and fuel type.

The corresponding retired WREGIS certificates are listed in Attachment 2 to this Report.

Attachment 3 details which certificates PSE used for its voluntary renewable energy programs in 2022.
