ERRATA TO NOTICE OF VIRTUAL SETTLEMENT HEARING (To begin immediately following the open meeting on April 22, 2021)

TO ALL PARTIES:

On December 9, 2020, Puget Sound Energy (PSE or Company) filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) revisions to its currently effective electric tariff, WN U-60, Tariff G. PSE characterizes its filing as a Power Cost Only Rate Case (PCORC), as authorized by the Settlement Stipulation approved by the Commission in Dockets UE-011570 and UG-011571.

On January 14, 2021, the Commission entered its Prehearing Conference Order; Notice of Hearing (PHC Order), which established a procedural schedule that included, among other things, an evidentiary hearing set to begin at approximately 9:30 a.m., immediately following the Commission's regularly scheduled open meeting on April 22, 2021, and continue, if necessary, on April 23, 2021. The Commission subsequently suspended the procedural schedule, preserving the hearing dates for a possible settlement hearing.

On April 6, 2021, the Commission issued a Notice of Virtual Settlement Hearing (Notice), setting a settlement hearing to begin at 9:30 a.m. on April 22, 2021, and continue as needed on April 23, 2021.

To prevent an internal scheduling conflict, the Commission hereby corrects the start time of the settlement hearing to conform with the originally scheduled evidentiary hearing set by the PHC Order. The settlement hearing on April 22, 2021 will begin *at approximately 9:30 a.m.*, *immediately following the Commission's regularly scheduled open meeting*.
