Dear Amanda Maxwell:

On July 7, 2016, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered Order 04 Final Order Approving Settlement Agreement (Order 04)in the above-referenced docket. Order 04, among other things, required Cascade Natural Gas Corporation (Cascade) to file an annual report with the Commission each year regarding the Company's Washington Energy Assistance Fund (WEAF) program by January 15 of each year.

On January 10, 2022, Cascade filed with the Commission its 2020-2021 annual WEAF report. The Company's Report provides information about the annual budget, actual program cost, reimbursement for Community Action Agencies' (CAA) program delivery cost, and Cascade's administrative costs for WEAF.

Commission Staff (Staff) reviewed the compliance filing provided by Cascade dated January 10, 2022 and finds that it contains sufficient detail with respect to the annual budget, actual program cost, reimbursement for CAA's program delivery cost, and Cascade's administrative costs for WEAF. Therefore, Staff believes that the filing complies with the Commission's Order 04, entered July 7, 2016.
