## NOTICE EXTENDING DEADLINE TO FILE SETTLEMENT DOCUMENTS (By April 30, 2019)

Re: In the Matter of Determining the Proper Carrier Classification of, and Complaint for Penalties against, BM Logistics d/b/a Bogdan Movers, Docket TV-190023

In the Matter of Determining the Proper Carrier Classification of, and Complaint for Penalties against Bogdan Momotyuk d/b/a Bogdan Delivery LLC, Docket TV-170746 (consolidated)

## TO ALL PARTIES:

On March 27, 2019, Administrative Law Judge Laura Chartoff convened a brief adjudicative proceeding in consolidated Dockets TV-190023 and TV-170746. At the outset, Commission staff (Staff) and Bogdan Momotyuk d/b/a Bogdan Delivery LLC (Bogdan Movers or Company) announced they had reached a settlement in principle, but that they needed more time to finalize the settlement. The Staff and the Company (collectively, the Parties) moved for a continuance and suspension of the procedural schedule, and requested that they be permitted to file a settlement agreement and supporting documentation no later than April 17, 2019. Judge Chartoff orally granted the Parties' motion at the hearing, and on March 28, 2019, the Commission issued a notice requiring Parties to file settlement documents or a status report no later than April 17, 2019.

On April 17, 2019, Staff filed a letter in this docket stating that the settlement has not been finalized due to a personal matter affecting Bogdan Mover's counsel, and requesting that the deadline to file the settlement documents be continued to April 30, 2019.

The Commission finds good cause to continue the deadline to April 30, 2019, to allow the parties time to finalize the details of the settlement.

THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE That the parties must file a settlement agreement and supporting documentation no later than 5 p.m., April 30, 2019.
