Regarding Informal Draft Community Solar Rules

480-xxx-006 definitions: Northwest Renewables recommends language allowing for the utilization of investments from passive owners (for tax equity). Some clarity about passive owners not being subject to regulation is needed.

480-xxx-030 Registration as a community solar company: Northwest Renewables does agree with the requirement for performance bonding for registration in the interest of protecting subscribers to Community Solar projects.

480-xxx-030 Registration as a community solar company: In the interest of protecting subscribers to Community Solar projects, Northwest Renewables does agree with the draft language requiring technical expertise on part of the Community Solar Company prior to registration. Technical expertise ought to include a minimum 6,000 hours in the solar-energy-industry by a full-time employee or Owner, recorded in process as per Labor and Industries' Master Electrician licensing process, and a National American Board of Certified Energy Practitioners (NABCEP) accreditation by a full-time employee or Owner.

480-xxx-030 Disposition or transfer: Northwest Renewables recommends edits allowing a Community Solar Company to define the transportability or portability of its Community Solar Project's shares on a per-project basis. Disposition or transfer clauses must be addressed in the subscription contract, and in the interest of protecting subscribers, may not be changed for the lifetime of the project.
