NOTICE OF ERRATA TO ORDER 01

Re: *Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission v. Summit View Water Works*
Docket UW-240589

TO ALL PARTIES:

On September 26, 2024, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) issued Order 01, Complaint and Order Suspending Tariff Revisions (Order 01) in Docket UW-240589. Some of the discussion from the open meeting was not reflected in Order 01 – to provide additional guidance to staff, three additional paragraphs have been added.

A new Paragraph 21 is hereby added to read as follows:

- 21 (10) Beyond the discreet issues raised by this specific matter, there is a more general need for the Commission to reevaluate its treatment of cost of capital for water utilities.

New Paragraphs 26 and 27 are hereby added to read as follows:

- 26 (5) The parties may conduct discovery pursuant to the Commission’s discovery rules in WAC 480-07-400 – 425 and the Commission will issue a Protective Order as soon as possible in this Docket.
- 27 (6) Staff shall open a docket for a policy and interpretive statement on water cost of capital, so as to facilitate a simultaneous discussion of capital structure, cost of debt, and Return on Equity, by October 25, 2024.

Additionally, it has come to the Commission’s attention that the signature block of Order 01 erroneously lists Chair David Danner, who was not present at the September 26, 2024, open meeting. The corrected Order removes the Chair’s signature, and is attached hereto.
