TO THE PARTIES:

On October 7, 2003, WeBTEC, ATG, Integra and MCI filed a Joint Motion that requests Commission Staff and Public Counsel to re-survey CLECs and recompile the data they submit. The moving parties contend that when CLECs initially responded to the Commission's Order No. 06 requiring them to disclose the local business services they provide in Washington, the CLECs did not properly distinguish between analog and digital services in their responses. Since Qwest's application encompasses only analog services, the CLECs should only have responded with information about analog local business services they provide in competition with Qwest. The moving parties further contend that as a result of CLEC confusion on the issue, the Staff aggregation of CLEC raw data is seriously compromised.
