Staff believes that Inland's response to Staff's Motion for Summary Determination raises issues/facts that necessitate a reply from Staff. Specifically, from Staff's perspective Inland improperly raises issues/facts not raised in its initial round of testimony. Staff wishes to object to these issues/facts. Additionally, Inland's response raises procedural issues regarding what may be considered under motions for summary determination and the proper standard of proof, which may have implications for other proceedings. Therefore, Staff requests the opportunity to file a reply to Inland's response on January 17, 2006.
