4 **Q. Please state your name and business address.**

5 A. My name is Katherine J. Barnard. My business address is 10885 NE Fourth  
6 Street, Bellevue, Washington, 98004-5591.

7 **Q. By whom are you employed and in what capacity?**

8 A. I am Director of Revenue Requirements and Regulatory Compliance for Puget  
9 Sound Energy (“PSE”).

10 **Q. What are your duties as Director of Revenue Requirements and Regulatory**  
11 **Compliance for PSE?**

12 A. As Director of Revenue Requirements and Regulatory Compliance, I am  
13 responsible for strategy, policy, direction and coordination of PSE’s interests on  
14 state regulatory issues. I oversee state regulatory processes and compliance  
15 requirements, including, audits, rate cases and regulatory proceedings. I represent  
16 PSE in regulatory issues with state regulators and other constituents. I negotiate  
17 rate and tariff issues with customers, agencies, stakeholders and regulators.

1 **Q. Briefly describe your education and relevant employment experience.**

2 A. I graduated from the University of Washington with Bachelor of Arts degrees in  
3 Business Administration and Arts & Sciences. The Bachelor of Arts degree in  
4 Business Administration was in Finance with additional course work in  
5 accounting.

6 From 1985 to 1987, I was employed by Ernst & Whinney's Telecommunications  
7 Consulting Group, where I was responsible for the preparation of cost allocation  
8 studies for several small telephone companies. From 1988 to 1990, I was the  
9 Manager – Separations at Nevada Bell where I developed rates for Nevada Bell's  
10 Federal Communications Commission tariff filings along with Federal  
11 Communications Commission and National Exchange Carriers Association  
12 compliance reporting. From 1990 to 1992, I was employed by the Washington  
13 Utilities and Transportation Commission as Revenue Requirement Specialist. My  
14 responsibilities included reviewing tariff filings, affiliated interest applications,  
15 and performing audits of several telephone companies' compliance reports. From  
16 1992 to 2011, I was employed by Cascade Natural Gas Corporation. Between  
17 1992 and 1996, I served as a Senior Accountant, in which role I was responsible  
18 for developing the jurisdictional balances used in regulatory reporting. From 1996  
19 to 2011, I worked in the Regulatory Affairs department of Cascade Natural Gas  
20 Company and served as Manager of Regulatory Affairs prior to my departure in  
21 June 2011. In July 2011, I joined PSE in my current role. I have testified as a  
22 company witness in state rate cases and other regulatory proceedings.
