**NOTICE OF EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE RESPONSES
TO MOTION FOR SUMMARY DETERMINATION
(Due on Tuesday, February 1, 2005)**

RE: *Sandra Judd et al. v. AT&T Communications of the Pacific Northwest, Inc., and T-Netix, Inc.*; Docket No. UT-042022.

TO PARTIES OF RECORD:

On December 21, 2004, complainants Sandy Judd and Tara Herivel filed with the Commission a Motion for Continuance of Response Deadline to AT&T's Motion for Summary Determination. By notice dated December 22, 2004, the Commission granted the complainant's request for an extension of time to file a response to AT&T's motion to February 1, 2005, due to the lack of availability of counsel and the need to conduct discovery on matters raised in AT&T's motion.

On December 30, 2004, T-NETIX, Inc., filed a similar motion for continuance to respond to AT&T's motion. T-NETIX reports that counsel for the complainant's and AT&T do not object to a similar extension of time for T-NETIX. T-NETIX demonstrates good cause under WAC 480-07-385(2) and (3)(a) for an extension of time to file a response to AT&T's motion. **T-NETIX's request for an extension of time file a response to AT&T's motion for summary determination until Tuesday, February 1, 2005, is granted.**
