AMENDMENT 25 TO THE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES AGREEMENT BETWEEN VERIZON SERVICES ORGANIZATION INC. AND MCI COMMUNICATIONS SERVICES, INC.

This Amendment 25 to the Telecommunications Services Agreement (Contract No. TSA010302-1) (Agreement) by and between MCI Communications Services, Inc. d/b/a Verizon Business Services, a Delaware corporation, with offices at 6929 North Lakewood Avenue, Tulsa, Oklahoma 74117 ("Provider") and Verizon Services Organization Inc., a Delaware corporation, with offices at 6665 N. McArthur Boulevard, Irving, Texas 75039 ("Customer") shall be effective as of the date set forth below.

1. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This Amendment 25 shall be effective upon the execution by both parties (the "Amendment 25 Effective Date").

2. PRIOR AMENDMENT.

The parties previously entered into Amendment 20, which created a new Section 41 adding WAVELENGTH Service to the Agreement. As of the Amendment 25 Effective Date, the parties agree to delete Section 41 created by Amendment 20 in its entirety and replace it with the new Section 41 created by this Amendment 25.

- 3. AGREEMENT MODIFICATION.
 - 3.1 ADD a new Section 41, US WAVELENGTH Service, to Exhibit C as set forth in Attachment 1 of this Amendment.
- 4. OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS.

Except as specifically amended herein, the terms and conditions of the Agreement, including any Amendments thereto, shall remain in full force and effect during the term of the Agreement.

41. US WAVELENGTH SERVICE

- 41.1 <u>Scope.</u> Upon Customer's request and where available, Provider will provide and Customer agrees to pay for 2.5 or 10 Gbps Option 1 Type I interLATA or intraLATA optical circuits delivered as a protected or unprotected signal using Dense Wave Division Multiplexing (DWDM) and Optical Add/Drop Multiplexing (OADM) technology ("US WAVELENGTH Service"). US WAVELENGTH Service is delivered using one of several option interfaces, including without limitation, GigE, OC-48 SONET, OC-192 SONET, ESCON, FICON and Fiber Channel.
- 41.2 <u>Charges for US WAVELENGTH Service</u>. Customer's charges for US WAVELENGTH Service will be as set forth below.
 - 41.2.1 Monthly Recurring Charge: \$19.35 per mile per circuit.
 - 41.2.2 Nonrecurring Charge: Customer agrees to pay Verizon a one-time charge of FOUR HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$400,000) each time a new node or location is inserted into an existing ring.
 - 41.2.3 Customer also agrees to pay Verizon additional charges, as mutually agreed to by both parties and in accordance with the affiliate transaction requirements set forth in 47 CFR, Parts 32 and 64, including without limitation, any extraordinary charges associated with the provisioning of US WAVELENGTH Service (e.g., capital expenditures or other charges related to unforeseen circumstances).
