It came to my attention after the prehearing hearing conference earlier this afternoon that the Commission did not send a notice of hearing to certain persons who filed comments in the early stages of these dockets. The only non-Commission persons receiving that notice were Mr. Weaver for the Company, and his attorney at that time, Mr. Finnigan.

I recommend the Commission issue another notice to the commenters and others who may be on a Commission interested party list. I do not know if any such person is actually interested in becoming a party. I have not communicated with any of these people. However, it is better to address this now than to get an intervention request months down the line, when the case schedule could be adversely impacted.
