**NOTICE CANCELLING STATUS CONFERENCE  
AND  
NOTICE GRANTING MOTION FOR SECOND CONTINUANCE**

Re: *Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission, Complainant, v. Murrey's Disposal Company, Inc., G-9, Respondent, Docket TG-130501 and Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission, Complainant, v. American Disposal Company, Inc., G-87, Respondent, Docket TG-130502 (consolidated)*

TO ALL PARTIES:

On May 21, 2013, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) issued Order 02 – Prehearing Conference Order; Order of Consolidation; Notice of Status Conference; and Notice of Hearing in the above-referenced dockets establishing a procedural schedule. As part of this Order, the Commission scheduled a status conference for July 12, 2013, and adopted various testimony deadlines as proposed by the parties. The Commission subsequently modified these deadlines on June 20, 2013, at the parties' request.

The parties filed a second motion for continuance on July 11, 2013, requesting a 48-hour continuance of the parties' testimony filing deadlines, "while ongoing settlement negotiations continue."<sup>1</sup>

All parties agree to the continuance. The continuance is minor, at only 48-hours, and should foster judicial economy by narrowing contested issues and possibly producing a settlement agreement. The Commission finds the parties' settlement negotiations constitute good cause to cancel the status conference and grants the parties' requested continuance.
