Dear Sir or Madam:

As you are aware, on October 25, 2016, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission issued Order 02 imposing penalties in the amount of \$5,000, and suspending \$4,500 on condition of future compliance, i.e., ceasing and desisting all operations, and paying the unsuspended portion of the penalty. On March 2, 2018, the Commission issued Order 03 Imposing Suspended Penalty, in the amount of \$4,500, for continuing to operate without first obtaining a certificate from the Commission. The Commission sent you a Final Notice dated December 13, 2018, indicating that the \$4,500 balance was due. To date, the Commission has not received the remaining balance.

This is to notify you that the Commission intends to forward your outstanding debt to a collection agency for collection. You likely will incur additional expenses and fees, including costs of collection, attorney's fees, and interest. These expenses and fees will be added to your outstanding \$4,500 balance.
