RE: Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission v. Safe-To-Go-Movers, LLC Commission Staff Recommendation to Waive Suspended Penalties of Order 04/03 Dockets TV-190514, TV-190515, and TV-200161 (Consolidated)

Dear Ms. Maxwell:

On May 29, 2020, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission entered Order 04/03 (Order), Initial Order Approving Settlement Agreement in Dockets TV-190514, TV-190515, and TV-200161 (Consolidated). The Order approved the settlement agreement between Commission staff (Staff) and Safe-To-Go-Movers, LLC, (STG or Company) which imposed a \$5,000 suspended penalty in Dockets TV-190514 and TV-190515. The Order further imposed a \$5,400 penalty against STG in Docket TV-200161, suspending the entire penalty for a period of two years, and then waiving it on condition that STG not incur any repeat critical or acute violations when Staff conducts a follow-up investigation at least six months from the date of the Order.

On February 1, 2021, Staff completed the required follow-up investigation. The Company did not receive any repeat acute or critical violations.

Staff finds that STG satisfied the conditions of the Order and recommends that the \$5,400 suspended penalty be waived.
